- Mr. Ritik Kumar from SE – EXTC won the quiz with 17 marks.

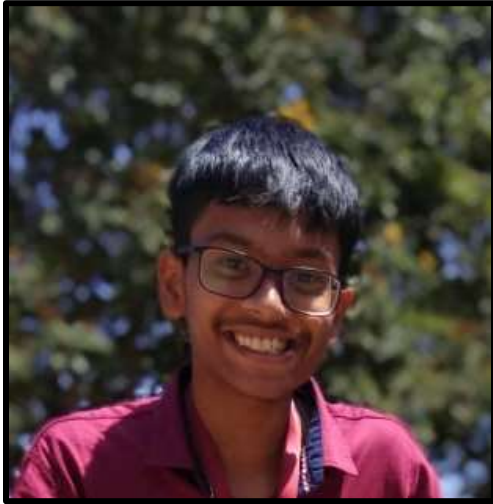
